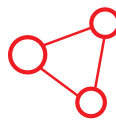

The legal basis for the collection and processing of your personal data is:	1. Medical and special needs support: that you have given explicit consent by answering the question. 3. Equality and inclusion: that you have given your explicit consent by answering the question(s). 4. Direct marketing: that you have given your consent. 5. In all other cases: that it is necessary for our legitimate interests, which are to build a programme to encourage participation in cricket and to ensure that the reputation of cricket is preserved, and this does not prejudice or harm your rights and freedom or those of parents / guardians of children and / or that it is necessary for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.	Your right to withdraw consent	Where you have given consent, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. If you or they do, it will not affect the lawfulness of any processing for which we had consent prior to you withdrawing it.	
		Location of your personal data	We will normally keep your personal data within the United Kingdom or the European Economic Area.	
How long we will keep your personal data for?	We will normally keep your personal data for two years after your last engagement with us. After this time period we will anonymise your information and keep for analysis of engagement trends.	Your rights in respect of your personal data	You have the right of access to your personal data and, in some cases, to require us to restrict, erase or rectify it or to object to our processing it, and the right of data portability.

The Direct Debit Guarantee



- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit England and Wales Cricket Board Ltd will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request England and Wales Cricket Board Ltd to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by England and Wales Cricket Board Ltd or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society
 - If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when England and Wales Cricket Board Ltd asks you to
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
